- **energy consumption is systematically evaluated.**
- **energy flows are recorded and kept updated.**
- **continuous improvement of the energy-related performance.**
- **energy-saving measures get planned and implemented.**
- **results of energy-saving measures get evaluated at regular intervals.**
- **planned activities to improve energy efficiency are continuously updated to the latest state of the art.**
- **identify and implement the current legal requirements (binding obligations)**

In order to implement energy policy, an energy manager and environmental management officer will be named and an annual budget established.
